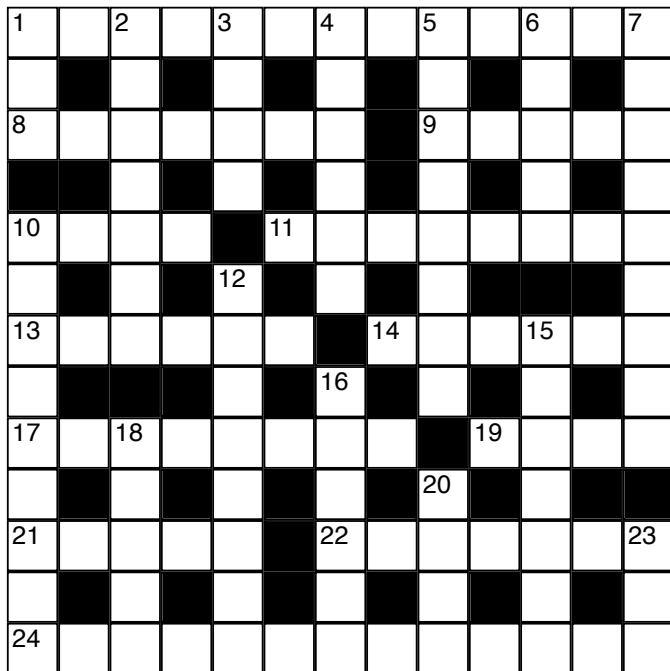

Mobile phone and personal music devices: Don't forget to make a note of the IME number of a mobile phone, to find it key in *#06#, with this if it's stolen you can block it. On many mobile phones you can download an "App" to find your phone and more importantly wipe that data stored on it, check your "App store" or mobile phone provider. When texting or talking on phones, or listening to music remain "in touch" with your surroundings, a number of road accidents, thefts and assaults occur when we fail to note what's going on around us, don't forget to pass it on to the children.
