Sudbury Symphony Orchestra is pleased to announce the return of Thomas Isaac, one of Britain's up and coming cello superstars, to perform Dvorak's masterful cello concerto in their concert on Sunday 26th November. Thomas

began playing cello at the age of 6, and is continuing his studies at the Royal Academy of Music where in 2015 he won first prize for his performance of Bach's Suite for Cello no 2. He performs with many leading orchestras and as Principal Orchestral cellist both in the UK and Europe and has appeared in a BBC Proms Extra concert. As a soloist Thomas has performed in many venues including the Wigmore Hall.

Dvorak's cello concerto is an exquisite piece, giving voice to the whole range of cello registers from soprano to haunting soft melodies to deeper, passionate intensities and stunning chords, neatly blended with instrumental leads and echoes from woodwind, brass all interwoven into a backdrop of orchestral sound.

Sudbury Symphony Orchestra will also be performing Beethoven's 1st symphony. The lyrical but unusual introduction, sometimes referred to as a 'musical joke' as the chords are in 'the wrong key', gives way to a vast spectrum of melodic sounds as the movement and the symphony unfold around you.

We hope you will join us for a very special musical evening.
